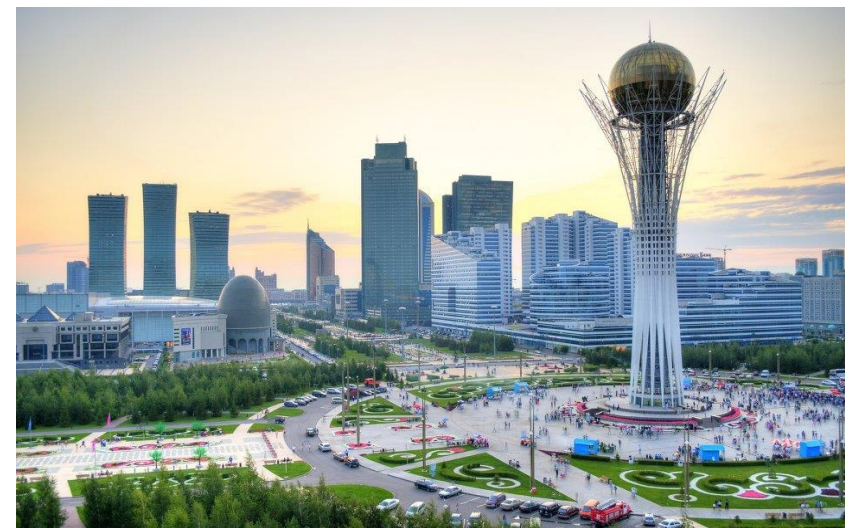

Why

The Astana Medical University, due to the creation of the “Management Control System Office”, “Business Intelligence Office”, “Strategic Development Office”, “Information Technology/Data Collection-Extraction Office”, “Technology-Policy-Projects Assessment Office”, has decided to promote a preparatory course in order to facilitate the spread of knowledge about such topics.

The participation will be an advantage for those who would like to enhance their own curriculum vitae with a managerial publication of the strategic and operative plan of the AMU University and to apply for the selections in order to work in the offices that will be set up in the AMU University or others offices related to them.

To whom

The school is designed for post graduated professionals at international level interested in the field of Management Control System and Business Intelligence but also Strategic Planning. Seats are limited and participation confirmation is subject to the approval of the Summer School organizers.

What

This course defines at how to design performance measurement systems by looking at different types of indicators and how to translate data into information, how to use advanced low-cost tools and software in order to monitor, control and support decision making processes and activities such as balance scorecards, cost analysis, strategy planning, etc.

Prize module 5° week 5 August – 11 August

Best students selected during the course will be divided in two groups and they will create the strategic plan and the operative plan of the AMU University. Plans will be published and students will achieve the possibility to enhance their own curriculum vitae with a managerial publication and to be selected to work in the new University offices that will be set up.

How

The program includes presentations, group works, “hands on” activities and frontal and online lessons. The approach is team based to stimulate the competition within the students to achieve a better learning improvement.

Assessment

We expect all participants to attend at least 80% of the lessons to be allowed to participate to the final exam and obtain the Summer School Certificate as well as the possibility to access the Prize Module. The Prize Module access is reserved to whom that have passed at least 1 out of 4 week exams.
